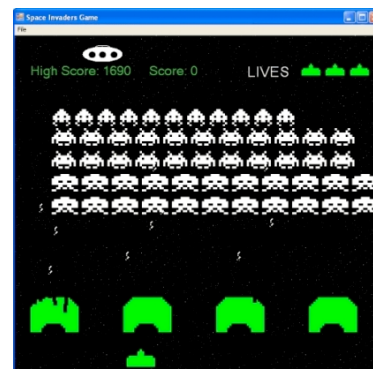


Gamemaker Workshop

The Gamemaker Video Game Creation programs teach students the fundamentals of computer programming and video game design. Each with their own laptop (for the duration of class anyway!), students will program a variety of age-appropriate computer games using the CTWorkshop Gamemaker tutorials. They will learn how to create characters, make them move throughout the game and interact with other game objects. While customization and creativity are encouraged, we do maintain a strict non-violence policy.
